

People's Watch—An Overview

People's Watch ("PW") is a human rights organisation that has been actively engaging itself in the protection and promotion of human rights and fundamental freedoms in Rajasthan since 1995. After eleven years of work, PW has expanded its concerns across India.

Vision

A society free from human rights violations and discrimination to be built through cultivating a human rights culture and building a participatory democracy.

Mission

- Protection of human rights through monitoring human rights violations, intervention and building solidarity with people's struggle for human rights.
- Promoting human rights culture through education and conscientising the larger community.

Brief History and Background

In 1993, Mr. Henri Tiphagne, Executive Director of PW and a passionate human rights advocate since 1977, became determined to professionalise human rights responses in the state of Rajasthan in India. He and like-minded people such as Dr. Devasahayam, the present Director of the Institute of Human Rights Education, and Fr. Diamond Raj, a Catholic Priest with the Archdiocese of Madurai, founded PW in December 1995 along with a team of Advisory Board members. In its nascent stage, the organisation was entirely committed to monitoring the state to improve accountability for human rights violations. Over time, the organisation expanded into the fields of legal intervention, rehabilitation, and campaigning. PW now boasts a legal team committed to intervening on behalf of torture victims and a Rehabilitation Centre for victims of domestic violence and torture, where victims receive housing and support. Its Campaign Unit works to improve human rights awareness throughout the community and to engage other organisations in the struggle. It is particularly engaged in building what is popularly known as the 'Citizens for Human Rights Movement.' Its Human Rights Education program has successfully introduced the concept of human rights into school curricula in over fourteen states across the country. The program is based on the strongly held belief that the value of rights can be firmly established only when instilled in the minds of children as a social virtue, as a value to be safeguarded and protected as something stable and indestructible.

The National Project on Preventing Torture in India

People's Watch, in league with the Friedrich Naumann Stiftung, began the National Project on Preventing Torture in India (NPPTI) in January 2006 with a grant from the European Union under the EIDHR. The primary aim of the action is to initiate and to model a national campaign for the prevention of torture in India, with a deliberate focus on torture practices routinely employed by police. The project focuses especially upon safeguarding groups on the margins of Indian society, such as Dalit, tribal groups, minorities, women and children.

The project consists of two major stages:

1. Formation of nine State-wide networks to monitor instances of torture and to intervene on behalf of victims.
2. A national campaign against torture that uses monitoring data to develop public awareness, to train professionals, to improve institutional responses to abuse, and to lobby for India's ratification of the United Nations Convention Against Torture (CAT) and its Optional Protocols.

The Project's design reflects priorities set by the European Commission's EIDHR Call for Proposals—specifically, research on torture practices, legal support for victims, awareness-raising, and legislative lobbying.

In the years 2006 and 2007, the Project has undertaken the following in the State of Rajasthan:

The overall goal of the Project is the prevention and reduction of torture in India, where police abuses remain an entrenched and often routine law enforcement strategy despite India's status as the world's largest democracy. The Project confronts frequent police practices that include assault and physical abuse, custodial death,



custodial rape, threats and psychological humiliation, and deprivation of food, water, sleep, and medical attention.

The primary goals of the Project are as follows:

- Protecting potential victims of torture, particularly those belonging to vulnerable and marginalised communities.
- Highlighting individual cases of torture as they occur
- Improving institutional responses to instances of torture by demanding state accountability
- Advancing an ethic of responsibility and restraint among law-enforcement officers
- Educating and enlisting professional groups such as lawyers, social activists, doctors, psychiatrists, journalists, and teachers in the campaign to prevent and to eliminate torture
- Raising public awareness of torture as an unlawful and widespread abuse of police powers
- Promoting favourable policy outcomes in the form of new domestic anti-torture legislation and commitments to existing international treaties

Ultimately, one of the most enduring effects of the Project will be the model that it sets for addressing issues of torture nationally. Recognising that there are insufficient resources to stanch the practice of torture nationally, PW has sought to create an example for preventing torture that can be duplicated. A key aspect of this approach is the “model taluk,” in which monitoring and campaigning efforts will be intensely focussed in one “taluk” (an administrative subdivision of a district) in each State, with the goal of working towards the elimination of torture practices entirely. This model will create a paradigm for the prevention and elimination of torture on a much larger scale.

Why This Report?

This report falls under the “Campaign Against Torture” segment of the NPPTI. It seeks to raise awareness of torture and ultimately to influence policies relating to the misuse of official power. The basic thrust of the report is to reveal the context in which PW felt compelled to undertake the NPPTI. This contextual picture is painted by examining three major categories:

1. Data on actual occurrences of torture and police misbehaviour from 2000-2006, collected through state-level organisations and secondary source research
2. An analysis of trends that emerge from the data, with special attention to the effects of torture on marginalised groups such as Dalits and women
3. Institutional responses at the state level

Ultimately, the research reveals a sad scene, in which rhetoric is abundant and action scarce. Indeed, despite its refusal to ratify the CAT or expressly to criminalise torture, India continuously pays lip service to the prevention of torture through its Parliament, Courts, and Commissions. Yet the data reveal an appalling prevalence of police misconduct, including the use of torture as a common interrogation method. Institutional responses are anaemic, in terms of both documentation and concrete preventive actions.

Aside from raising awareness, then, this report aims to combat the complacency and denial that define the Indian Government’s response to such blatant human rights transgressions. It provides irrefutable proof that invites Indian policymakers to acknowledge the extent of torture practices in the country and to take a participatory role in ensuring that basic human rights are guaranteed to all of India’s citizens. By demanding a dialogue on the issue, PW hopes to end the silence that continues to expose hundreds of thousands of Indians to the practice of torture every year.

Nangi, Phagi Tehsil, Jaipur

4 October 2004

- On 4 October 2004, Nangi, age 19, died while in the custody of Rajasthan Police.

- Kamal Jain and five others were arrested on 29 June 2005 for betting.
- Kamal Jain died in custody in the Dug PS.

Biswas, Shyamul, Jaipur

22 September 2006

- On 22 September 2006, Shyamul Biswas, age 35, was arrested in connection with a murder. The police took Biswas to the Ashok Nagar PS.
- On 27 September 2006, Biswas died in the Ashok Nagar PS. There were three injury marks identified on Biswas' face, blood found in his nostrils, and swelling in his genitalia.

Corporal Maqsood, Rajasthan

22 June 2002

- Corporal Maqsood was a Pakistani border guard. Maqsood was shot dead at point blank range after being tortured.
- Before being killed, Maqsood was shot in the leg, burnt with cigarette butts, and severely beaten.
- Maqsood's body was found mutilated.

Chohan, Kamala, Jaipur

1 June 2006

- On 28 May 2006, Chomu PS police officers arrested Chohan's son. On 1 June 2006, the police called Chohan, a Dalit, to come to the Chomu PS.
- At the Chomu PS, the police officers tortured Chohan and rendered her unconscious. By the time she was admitted to the hospital, Chohan had already died.
- The police refused to register the FIR filed by Chohan's son.

October 2006

- In October 2006, Raj died of poisoning in custody after being arrested in connection with a theft case.
- In response, the State Government removed twenty-five policemen and a judicial inquiry was ordered.

- In October 2006, Singh was killed by police in an alleged fake encounter in Jaipur.

- On 15 August 2000, BSF Constable Jamil Iqbal was drunk, and he shot and killed Prakash and Ram.

3. Police Rape

Dalit Female Sarpanch, Jhalawar

22 September 2005

- On 22 September 2005, the sarpanch went to the Gangdhar PS to complain about corporal punishment meted out to students of a local school by two teachers.
- Gangdhar PS SHO Fateh Singh Chouhan and ASI Ganga Ram, along with two local BJP leaders, first beat the sarpanch and then raped her.
- The sarpanch was then pushed out of the police station.
- No medical examination or other investigation was carried out despite the fact that the clothes the sarpanch was wearing during the rape remain intact.
- The sarpanch lodged a complaint, but no police action has been taken to register

a corresponding case. The sarpanch appealed to the Collector and Superintendent of Police to no avail.

Dalit BA Student, Bhilwara

18 January 2006

- Constable Moti Ram continuously raped a Dalit BA student continuously for six months. Constable Ram eventually impregnated the student.
- Constable Ram threatened the student with serious consequences if she did not have an abortion.

4. Police Torture

Lal, Bhonri, Naudeva Village

6 April 2006

- The victim Bhonri Lal was arrested by Bandikui PS police officers in the Dausa district.
- The police beat Lal and forced him to drink urine from his shoes.
- The State human rights commission has ordered the I.G. to investigate the case.

Lal, Ganesh, Swaimadhapur

15 January 2006

- Ganesh Lal and his wife, both around the age of 70 and both Dalits, were attacked by some individuals based on their caste. The Lals' neighbor also filed a FIR against them.
- The police repeatedly tortured the Lals.

5. Police Violence

Bai, Gulab, Other Tribal Villagers, Mundiar Village, Baran

9 April 2003

- During Holi in Mundiar, a tehsildar (revenue administrator) insisted on playing Holi with the local Sahariyas (tribal women).
- When the women refused, the tehsildar man fondled the women and rammed his jeep against two bystanders.
- A scuffle broke out and someone slapped the tehsildar. He called the police.
- Soon after, a contingent of Rajasthan Armed Constabulary (RAC) jawans stormed the village, beating men, women and children with lathis. Among those the RAC jawans beat was Gulab Bai.
- On April 9, 2003 Gulab Bai died of her wounds.

Female Villagers, 22 MD Village, Jaipur

29 July 2005

- On 29 July, roughly 1,500 police conducted a pre-dawn raid against less than 150 villagers who had protested over the amount of irrigation water released to their farmlands through the Indira Gandhi Canal.
- The police officers beat the villagers, damaged property and stole cash, gold and ornaments.
- The police then refused to register a complaint on the villagers' behalf

Ramkishan, Bagadiya Bhawan

22 June 2006

- On 22 June 2006, Ramkishan, a Dalit police constable, stopped a lady and youth who were riding their motorbike without helmets.
- Later, at Ashok Nagar PS, Police Inspector Ratna Gupta beat Ramkishan, tore his clothes, and verbally abused him with caste-based insults.

27 October 2004

- On 27 October 2004, four farmers were killed and at least thirty others were injured as a result of a police firing in Gharsana Tehsil village.

- On 7 October 2004, school children, their parents, and villagers protested the transfer of their school principal who had improved the academic atmosphere.
- The Rajasthan Police arrived and fired into the crowd without provocation.

Gujjar, Devendra, Dholpur

6 June 2005

- On 6 June 2005, Kanchanpur PS police officers fired into a crowd of around 700 to 800 people protesting the death of an inmate in police custody.
- The Kanchanpur PS police officers killed Devendra Gujjar, age 14, in the firing.

13 June 2005

- Five people were killed as a result of a police firing into a crowd of 2,500 people demanding water from the Bisalpur Dam.
- Six other people sustained serious injuries.

Three Hindus, Gangapur

26 March 2002

- Police fired into a crowd of Hindus that had blocked a road in an attempt to not let a Muslim procession pass.

- Three people were killed by the police firing.
- Additional police forces were then deployed in the town and a curfew was imposed.

7. Police Inaction

Bhagwanti, Kumari, Hanumangar & Ganganagar
2000 – 2001

- Kumari Bhagwanti, age 14 and a member of a scheduled caste, was abducted by Rahitosh Godara & Krishnan Godara and raped by the two men.
- Afterwards, over the course of a two year period, Bhagwanti was raped by seventy or more men in Hanumangar and Ganganagar districts.
- On 18 October 2001, a social worker reported the incident to the Hanuman Garh PS. Kumari was examined and provided the names of more than seventy people in her FIR statements. However, the police only identified twenty-two people as the main suspects and arrested just fifteen of them.
- Seven main suspects, including Shakti Punia and Suresh Adovocate, who were powerful, upper-caste people in the area were excluded from investigation. Moreover, at the behest of influential people, the police tried to weaken the case by destroying evidence.
- Furthermore, the Bhagwanti and her parents were kept in the custody of those who were directly and indirectly involved in the crime.

Neelam, Shahadpur

22 September 2004

- Neelam and her friend ran away with two boys who belonged to a scheduled caste.
- On 28 August 2004, the police found the girls and returned them to their homes.
- In response to her behavior, Neelam's family killed her on the night of 22 September 2004. They cremated her body to destroy the evidence.
- The police took no independent action to investigate the case and they did not file a charge sheet.

Meghwal, Mohan Lal, Pali

1 March 2005

- Mohan Lal Meghwal, a Dalit, was standing for the Panchayat election in opposition of Shivdan Singh, who had controlled the Panchayat for the past few decades.
- Singh, along with his sons Tikam Singh and Diler Singh, killed Meghwal before the election. Singh and his sons stabbed Meghwal nineteen times before running him over with a tractor. The murder was committed in the middle of the day in front of many witnesses who did nothing.
- The police initially refused to register an FIR, but eventually did file one after substantial pressure from Dalit groups. While the Singh and his sons were arrested, they were soon released on bail.
- The police provided protection for the Singh family, but did not provide any protection for Meghwal's family, who received constant threats.

Dhaka Bai, Dausa

5 December 2005 – 6 July 2006

- In November 2005, Dhaka Bai was accused of casting a spell on another villager's grandson who had died. Armed villagers ransacked her house, injuring her and breaking her husband's hand. When she returned from the hospital, Bai was dragged into the village square and manhandled.

Banwari Lal replied that Hemraj Meena was inside. The SIs went inside and told Hemraj Meena that Sarpanch had called him, before beating him, pushing him outside, forcing him into the jeep, and taking him to the Atru PS.

Eight people, including Banwari Lal and Radhey Shyam, travelled by bike to the station, but Hemraj Meena was not there. The eight people looked for him at the Chowki, but did not find him there. They called Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar, who said that he would come in the morning.

At around 10.00pm, Banwari Lal and his companions returned to the station. Just then, the jeep arrived, but only SI Chauthmal was inside. The SI told them that Hemraj Meena would come soon, and then went inside to change his clothes.

After 20 minutes, the SI returned and told them that Hemraj Meena was in the Chowki, but that he had fallen from the jeep, injured his stomach, and been taken to the hospital.

The SI took Radhey Shyam to the hospital, where the latter learned that Hemraj Meena's condition was deteriorating. Radhey Shyam called Banwari Lal and told him the news. Banwari Lal and the others arrived and saw that Hemraj Meena was taken to Baran.

SI Jugal Kishore told Banwari Lal that Hemraj Meena had tried to jump from the moving jeep and had injured his head.

Banwari Lal, Radhey Shyam, and the others went to Baran, where they saw that Hemraj Meena was taken to Kota in an ambulance. Banwari Lal spoke with Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar, who said that he would ruin the whole family.

Banwari Lal, Radhey Shyam, and the others went in a jeep to Kota, where they had Hemraj Meena admitted to the MBS Hospital.

On 29 October 2007, Hemraj Meena's health degraded further.

On 30 October 2007 at 4.00am, Hemraj Meena died. Banwari Lal and the others fled.

Later, Banwari Lal was not allowed to get near Hemraj Meena's body or to talk to the doctors. When he and the others finally succeeded, they saw injury marks all over Hemraj Meena's body, especially on his back, hands, and legs.

After a post-mortem examination, Banwari Lal and the others retrieved Hemraj Meena's body. They, with Asesmbly Member Pramod Thapa, ex-Assembly Member Shiv Narayan Nagar, ex-District Chief Bharat Charan, and other important people from Meena put the body on the road and demanded compensation and the filing of a case against the police. District Collector Baran Sr. Pritam, Yashwant, and SP Ranjeet Singh arrived and ordered that a murder case be filed u/s 302 IPC against Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar.

At 4.45pm, the demonstrators took Hemraj Meena's body away and cremated it.

Banwari Lal later learned that the police had allegedly beaten Hemraj Meena almost to death after taking him to the forest on the orders of Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar. These orders allegedly followed a meeting on 27 October 2007 at which the beating was planned.

On 5 August 2006, the PC met Pappu and told him that Bhagchand was in jail. The PC told Pappu to have Bhagchand released on bail. On 6 August 2006, Pappu and Meera went and met Baghchand in the jail. Bhagchand told them to apply for bail when he was produced

at court on 10 August 2006. Before he was arrested, Bhagchand was very healthy, but at the jail Bhagchand was weak and his face was swollen.

On 7 August 2006, Bhagchand fainted in jail and was admitted in JLN hospital for treatment. At 7.30pm, Pappu went to the hospital and unsuccessfully searched for Bhagchand. Pappu returned home at 11.00pm. At about 3.00am on 8 August 2006, the same PC went to Bhagchand's house and informed that Bhagchand died in the hospital. The PC took Pappu's signature on a piece of paper, the contents of which he did not understand. When Pappu went to the hospital with his uncles to collect the body, the doctors told them that Bhagchand was dead when he was brought to the hospital.

The exact cause and circumstances of Bharat Kumar's death, and of his delayed admission to the Hospital, remain unclear.

Mohan Lal went to Bhawani Mandi on 14 January 2007, when he learned that Daya was dead.

However, the police allege that Daya told them he sold the jeep to Pawan, and the POs took Daya to Bhawani Mandi Railway Station to collect the money from Pawan. Then, while Daya was waiting with ASI Ganshyam Godham, PC Sahi Ram, PC Rek Raj, PC Murari Lal and Narendra, Daya jumped before a passing train and committed suicide.

Daya's body was kept at the Railway hospital mortuary. A postmortem was conducted the next day.

Umrao Devi was not home at the time. The police broke the front iron gate of her door and opened the latch, which

was locked from the inside, before searching her house. They opened the almirah in the wall. They searched Hemraj's room while they were sleeping, before beating Hemraj and taking him to the police station.

At the station, the police filed a false case against Hemraj, saying that they had found five illegal liquor bottles during their search. They put Hemraj in the lock-up.

The next day, the police produced Heraj before the court, which released him.

When Umrao Devi returned home and learned what had happened, she checked the almirah and found that Rs. 2,000, as well as a silver purse, a silver ring, and gold rings were missing.

Umrao Devi went to the station and demanded the return of her property, but the police refused. The police threatened to molest her and to arrest Hemraj on a false case if she proceeded against them.

Umrao Devi's neighbours are aware of the incident, but are too frightened to testify.

Umrao Devi filed a complaint in court. No action was taken.

At the same time, CI Chain Singh Mahecha, outraged, approached Rajendra Singh. The CI grabbed Rajendra Singh's collar and dragged him towards a police van. Between fifteen and twenty officers assisted the CI in pushing Rajendra Singh forcefully into the van.

Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena were taken to the Sadapura PS. There, PC Narendra Kumar Singh took all of the money from Rajendra Singh's pocket. Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena were kept in the lock-up for two hours.

Around four hundred members of the public opposed the police action, so the police shifted Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena to Shastri Nagar PS.

At 2.30pm, after further public pressure, the police released Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena.

The police have since filed a false case against Rajendra Singh.

When he entered the station, some officers confronted him and insulted his caste, demanding to know why he had come. When Adidan Ram Megwal replied, the policemen pushed him and he fell down. Adidan Ram Megwal left the station.

Later, Adidan Ram Megwal dragged an application and returned to the station, where he met the ASI and submitted his application. The ASI came with other officers to Adidan Ram Megwal's land, where they saw the damage. Instead of doing anything, the police demanded Rs. 1,000 from Adidan Ram Megwal as payment for hiring the jeep. Adidan Ram Megwal had only Rs. 500 in hand, which he gave to the police. Adidan Ram Megwal asked the officers to accompany him to the other villagers' residences, but they refused. They did, however, assure him that they would file his FIR.

The next day, Adidan Ram Megwal came to the station to collect a copy of his FIR, but the police asked him to return the next day.

A week passed after submission of Adidan Ram Megwal's complaint, and no action was taken.

On returning to Ajmer, Amrit Patel spoke with Devki Nandan and asked why he had taken over the property. Devki Nandan replied that Amrit Patel owed him rent. Amrit Patel insisted that no rent was pending, but Amrit Patel began to abuse and fight with him.

On 4 July 2007, Amrit Patel went to Ramganj PS to submit a written complaint to ASI Girdhari Lal. The ASI asked him who his landlord was; Amrit Patel replied that it was Devki Nandan. The ASI cautioned him against acting, saying that Devki Nandan was very influential with the police. The ASI refused to register a complaint and asked Amrit Patel to leave. Amrit Patel explained that Devki had illegal possession of his shop and his property and requested that the ASI take all necessary action to restore his livelihood. The ASI threatened to put Amrit Patel in the lock-up. Amrit Patel departed.

Later, Amrit Patel returned to the station, where he saw Devki Nandan with the police. The ASI yelled at him for coming again and slapped him in front of Devki Nandan. The ASI made Amrit Patel sit in a corner for four hours while the police drank liquor with Devki Nandan.

On 20 July 2007, Amrit Patel submitted a typed complaint to the SP (Ajmer) to take legal action against Devki Nandan. No action was taken.

The police proceeded to call Amrit Patel often to the station, where they humiliated him and forced him to withdraw his complaint under threat of imprisonment.

Jalli locked herself inside a room. The perpetrators broke open the door and attacked her with an axe, severely cutting her leg. Jalli fell unconscious from the injury. After the perpetrators left, Jalli was taken to Pushkar hospital. She was transferred to JLN hospital where she was treated for 20 days.

Ishwar attempted to lodge a complaint at the PS. However, POs refused to accept the complaint and told Ishwar not to return to the PS or they would make him drink urine.

While Jalli was unconscious in the hospital, ASI Phool Chand went and took her thumb prints on some papers. Moola saw ASI Phool Chand as he was leaving the ward.

Later, Jevra Ram Megwal, Ramu Devi, and Banshilal, their employer, and three others decided to go to the DSP; however, the DSP said that such cases were always false, and should not be registered under the SC/ST Act.

The DSP subsequently behaved rudely with the fact-finding team.

Phooli fell to the ground in pain. Only then, did the police intervene. Kaloo took Phooli to the hospital.

The next day Kaloo went to the PS to file a complaint. The POs beat Kaloo and threw him out of the PS.

In April 2006, the divorce was denied; Krishna Goyal filed an appeal that is currently pending in the High Court, as is her case u/s 498 IPC. Meanwhile, Krishna Goyal was granted Rs. 3,000 maintenance.

Between July 2006 and September 2007, Dinesh regularly harassed Krishna Goyal; amongst other things, he broke her glasses, snatched her bag, threw her down, kicked her, and punched her.

On 29 September 2007, Krishna Goyal filed an incident report in the Udhyog Nagar Thana. However, Dinesh continued to harass Krishna Goyal through early October 2007.

On 5 October 2007, Krishna Goyal went to Bhanwas Thana, but the police refused to file her report.

On 22 October 2007, Krishna Goyal's father complained to the SP (village). Dinesh continued to harass and to hurt Krishna Goyal.

Krishna Goyal met the SP (city), but no action was taken.

The speculator grabbed Labhchand Tailor's stick and stated to beat him with it. Labhchand Tailor fell down, but the speculator continued to beat him.

Labhchand Tailor managed to get inside the nearby Pushkar PS, where the speculator followed him. The speculator told him that no police officer would help him, as they all received their shares of the speculator's earnings.

The police refused to file a report against the speculator, instead pressuring Labhchand Tailor to compromise with him.

SI Singh explained that the BJP assembly member was an influential person and that the brothers were simply trying to defame his name. SI Singh chased the Kumar brothers from the Foyasagar PS.

On 21 July 2007, the BJP assembly man along with five others beat Kumar and his brother at his brother's house. The brothers escaped to the Foyasagar PS. At the police station, the BJP assembly man and his associates beat Kumar and his brother again in front of the police.

The Foyasagar PS police officers later arrested Kumar and two of the BJP assembly man's associates. SI Singh filed a mutual fight case and provided an injury report to all parties, despite the fact that only the Kumar brothers were injured.

While Kumar was detained, the police pressured him to withdraw the fight case against the BJP assembly man. Kumar ultimately withdrew the case and the police released him.

Makhan made several repeated requests to file the report, after which the Officer in Charge agreed to file the report on the condition that Makhan would not mention the Rs. 500/- previously taken. However, Makhan refused. The PC then told Makhan to leave or he would be locked up.

The next day Makhan attempted to file a complaint, but the POs refused to accept it.

According to the POs, on the day of the incident, Gajju and Makhan both attempted to file a complaint. When he told them the police could not accept a complaint from both parties, Makhan and Gajju said they would mutually resolve it and left without filing the report.

Unfortunately, Platform No. 2 did not have any facilities for meals, which annoyed the BSF soldiers. Some BSF soldiers approached E.R. Tirkey and asked him to move the train to Platform No. 1; however, Platform No. 1 was busy, so E.R. Tirkey could not do so.

BSF Officer Rastogi and his colleagues became angry. Officer Rastogi pointed his gun at E.R. Tirkey, who was startled, and begged to be given time to make some arrangements. E.R. Tirkey called Chief Officer Tarun Ji, but while he was talking another BSF Officer snapped the phone line. Two BSF Officers held E.R. Tirkey's hands and pushed him out of his office. Then the BSF personnel and took all the railway officers who were in the room – including Assistant Station Master A. Rathore, Shunting Masters Dhool Singh Bhati, Vishmprakash, and Ravikant Verma, and Chief Commercial Supervisor Arvind Mishra, among others – outside and made them stand in a queue. Seeing that the railway officers were queued up at gunpoint and surrounded by BSF soldiers, some bystanders were taken aback.

After a few minutes, the BSF soldiers sent the railway officers except E.R. Tirkey back into E.R. Tirkey's office and locked them inside. Two soldiers guarded the room.

Meanwhile, E.R. Tirkey was asked to stand in the sun with his hands raised. After approximately twenty minutes, he managed to call the police.

The GRP and RPF arrived and calmed the situation.

Later, one of the BSF soldiers apologised on all of their behalf to E.R. Tirkey.

The GRP and RPF, and BSF inquiry officers, promised to investigate the situation. No action was taken.

On 22 August 2007, the Baab PS police officers hung the four on two chairs and they were tied together for two hours. The Baab PS police officers beat them again and threatened to kill them. On 25 August 2007, two of the four were released.

In a separate incident, on 17 August 2007, SHO Ramchandsingh and other police officers came to victim Gangadevi's home and beat her. The police officers pressured Gagadevi to convince her husband and brother to confess to the commission of a murder case. The police officers told Gagadevi that her husband and brother would be killed if they did not confess. On 19 August 2007, Baab PS police officers ordered Gangadevi to the police station. She was beaten there, and detained overnight.

Jagdish Prasad, and SHO Sultan Khan told Channu that Nasir was wanted for eloping and marrying Reena, a politician's daughter, and that Reena's father had lodged a complaint against Nasir and Channu. The POs threaten Channu and used abusive languages. Channu suffered a heart attack at the PS. Instead of the POs taking Channu to the hospital, Channu's daughter Suraiya admitted him to the Mathuradas Mathur Hospital.

Sabeer was put in lock-up and interrogated all night. The police refused to give him food, and instead required his family to bring him food. Sabeer vomited from hunger. Sabeer remained in lock-up until 6 August 2007. During that time, the police permitted him to take food only once every 24 hours. On 7 August 2007, Sabeer was released by order of the Magistrate.

On 3 August 2007, POs arrested Karan Singh and interrogated him about the location of Nasir. When Karan said he had no information, four POs beat him. DYSP Sulesh Chowdry beat him with stick until he was unconscious. When he regained consciousness, the POs beat him again. Karan was detained until 7 August 2007, and was provided no food during his incarceration.

At that time POs came in search of Sharafat, and, when they did not find him, they arrested Vikas. At the PS POs interrogated Vikas about Sharafat's whereabouts. When Vikas was unable to give them any information, they beat him and put him in lock-up. A few hours later, Vikas was released on bail.

On 14 June 2007, Mahavir police went to Vikas' house and pulled him outside by his hair. He was arrested and taken to Mahavir PS. Vikas was released the next day. The POs took his mobile and refused to return it.

On 15 June 2007 at 5.00pm, Mahavir POs went to Deepa's house and asked her to come to the PS for an enquiry. Deepa refused and said she would answer any enquiry at her house. However, the POs forced Deepa and her children to go to the PS. At 8.00pm, Deepa was tied to a chair and beaten by CI Govind Singh and other policemen.

Deepa's mother learned of her arrest and later found her Mahavir PS. Vika's friend Ashu attempted to bring Deepa some food. Ashu found Deepa tied to a chair with her mouth gagged. The next day, Ashu returned to the PS with Deepa's mother. Deepa's children were handed over to Deepa's mother at 11.30am. Ashu saw Deepa when she came out to wash her hands; she appeared very badly beaten.

On 16 June 2007, Deepa was transferred to Vigyan Nagar PS where RPS Deepthi Agarwal and other policemen locked her in a cell and beat her face and back. Later during the day, SHO Hanuman Singh Nathawat went to the PS and saw Deepa in a critical condition. He ordered transferred from his station because the case was not under the jurisdiction of Vigyan Nagar PS.

Deepa was returned to Mahavir PS. On 17 June 2007, when her condition worsened, Deepa was released. Deepa's body was full blue patches from internal injuries. Deepa was unable to walk. She went up to the nearby telephone booth and called her mother. Immediately, Ashu and her mother rushed to telephone booth. They found her unconscious.

Deepa was taken to the government hospital where she narrated the episode to the media. Police from Vigyan Nagar PS learned about the disclosure, and went to the hospital. The POs threatened Deepa and forced the doctors to discharge her. Deepa was then treated by a private doctor.

After Amaram and Rafik left, Hanuman asked Om Prakash to remove him from the rope so he could go to the toilet. Allegedly, Hanuman was so scared of the shame to his family, he attempted to commit suicide by drinking of bottle of acid that was kept in the PS toilet. Hanuman started vomiting and Om Prakash took him to Beawar hospital.

The media printed the story in the newspaper. On the 27 April 2007, when Hanuman's father heard about Hanuman, he died of heart attack. The POs approached Hanuman's brother and asked him not to file any case against them. The POs offered to compensate them for the cost of Hanuman's medical expenses. The POs gave Rs. 5000 and food worth Rs.2000 during the mourning ceremony of Hanuman's father. However, the POs did not pay for any of Hanuman's hospital expenses. Meanwhile, Hanuman's condition worsened, and he remains in critical condition.

Out of fear, Hanuman's brothers have not filed a case against the POs.

Suddenly, about ten to fifteen men armed with swords, knives, and sticks entered the victims' land and started to attack them.

The police witnessed this event and then arrested the victims. En route to the police station, the police let half of Mangaram's descendents go. The rest – including Jassraj, Dhanaram, Shivalal, and Shantilal – were brought to the station, and made to stand half-naked. They had injuries to their heads, backs, and shoulders.

When some female family members went to visit the detainees, they were arrested, while the other detainees were released. No medical examinations were performed on any of those detained.

From 15 March 2007 to 30 March 2007, the police guarded the disputed land, drove away Mangaram's descendents, and seized their household items (including gas stoves and beddings, worth about Rs 50,000).

On 28 March 2007, the victims staged a protest and submitted a petition to the Collector, IG, and CM. No action was taken.

The family currently has no place to stay.

Victim Ramchandra, age 36, is of the Vishnoi caste (Backward Caste). On 21 October 2007, Ramchandra was at a bus stand, returning from Jodpur, when Blaesar Pos in civilian clothing arrived and took him into custody. The police pulled Ramchandra into their jeep and beat him.

Later, the police told Ramchandra that he was arrested in connection with an attack on the Harman Rag family, which occurred while Ramchandra was in Jodpur. While in custody, the police beat Ramchandra with lathis and sticks on his hands and legs until they bled. Throughout the night, the police deprived Ramchandra of sleep.

On 23 October 2007, the police produced Ramchandra before the court.

On 14 August 2007 at around 2.00pm, SHO Ramchandra Singh Rathore, PC Bhanwarlal Jyani (vishnoi), PC Preamsingh Ravlot, Driver Harchandraram Bhambhu, and HPC Kishanaram Meghwal went to victim Ramachandra Nai's house. Ramachandra Nai was a 51 year-old resident of Sihera village, Phalandi, Jodhpur. The POs arrested Ramchandra Nai, Ramachandra Nai's son Chaganlal, his brother-in-law Hariram and his brother-in-law's son Omprakash. They were taken to Phalandi City and then to Baap PS. The victims were put in lock up. Later that night, SHO Ramchandra arrested Jasraj, and also brought him to the Baap PS. All the victims were stripped of their clothes, locked in a cell, and deprived of food and water.

On 15 August 2007, victims were told that they were arrested for murdering Uttam Singh. The POs asked victims to admit the crime. Because they had no connection to the murder they denied the charges. The entire day, the POs pressured victims to admit they were responsible for the murder. That night, the SHO beat all the victims until they were unconscious. Ramchandra Nai was hung upside down by a rope and beaten severely. The POs forced Ramchandra Nai to sip urine from a cup. That night, the police prohibited victims from sleeping by forcing them to run the whole night.

In the afternoon of 16 August 2007, Dhanpat Samkhla and some PCs interrogated victims again. That night, the SHO beat Ramachandra and his son with a belt for an hour. Then all victims were again deprived of sleep and forced to run all night.

On 17 August, SHO Ramchandra Singh and some PCs went to Ramchandra Nai's home and assaulted Ramchandra Nai's wife Ganga Devi. On 19 August police arrested Ganga Devi and took her to the PS. Male PCs and the SHO beat her and prohibited her from sleeping. She was released on 20 August and had to find her own way home.

On 21 August the police again beat the five victims, and forced them to run all night.

Salim Mohammed s/o Munir, age 30yrs is a Shiya Muslim. He is educated upto Calss VIII and works as a mechanic. He lives in a rented house in Narsingpura Ajmer road, Tehsil Beawar District with his wife. He earns about Rupees three thousand per month.

On 4 March 2007 at 7 a.m., he heard a knock at his door and someone answered Salim that it was the milkman. But Salim does not have a milkman coming home and therefore went to the door to check. When he opened the door there were six policemen in civilian clothes waiting for him. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish and two other constables were there. They enquired if he was Salim and then caught him by his shirt

collar, held his hands firmly, forcibly put him in the jeep and took him to city police station. On reaching the station they enquired about a stolen table fan.

Salim had bought a table fan a week ago from a stranger who said he was selling his fan as needed money urgently. Salim explained this to the police, but was in vain. They asked him where he had kept the fan and when he said that it was at his house, they brought him home and they took the fan and Salim back to the police station.

He was detained in the police station for five days. His hands were tied behind and he was hung face downwards. He was tied the same way everyday during the nights. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish used to beat him with belts and sticks every night. In addition to the physical torture, he was verbally abused. They often referred to his caste while scolding him. They have stated the all Muslim were thieves. He had also kept him hungry and thirsty all the five days.

From 4 March 2007 to 7 March 2007 he was illegally detained in the police station. On 7 March a false theft was implicated on him. When Salim wanted to go home and asked the policemen to release him, they threatened that they would implicate him in any non bailable offence, if he spoke anything more.

When Salim's wife came to see him in the police station, she was asked to give Rs. 2000 (Rupees Two thousand only). On 9 March 2007, SI Likhma Ram and Aatma Ram took Rs. 10000 (Rupees Ten thousand only) from Salim and released him. They said that they would jeopardized him if spoke about his detention to anybody.

On 11 March 2007, he went to Amrit Kaur Hospital in Beawar for treatment. The doctor enquired about the injuries and refused to give treatment on hearing that the injuries were due to police torture. So he went to the medical store and bought a pain killer to relieve himself from pain for a short while. Then he went to ayurveda hospital, but his pain persisted. So, Salim went back to Amrit Kaur hospital. He managed to get an O.P. (Out Patient) ticket and met Dr. Hemant Chauhan. The doctor asked his name and refused to treat him. He said that he would not treat someone who was caught in a theft case. Immediately he went to the telegraph office and sent a complaint to the collector regarding incident by 1.10 p.m. (telegraph number 19096).

Victim Salim Mohammed, age 30 and a Muslim, is a mechanic and lives on Narsingpura Ajmer Road in Tehsil Beawar District.

On 4 March 2007, at 7:00am, six Beawar PS police officers came to Mohammed's door. Among the officers were SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish and two other unnamed constables. The officers forcibly put Mohammed in their jeep and transported him to the Beawar PS. At the station, the officers questioned Mohammed about a stolen table fan.

Mohammed explained to the police that he bought the fan from a stranger who claimed he needed money urgently. Mohammed went with the police back to the house to retrieve the fan. They all then returned to the Beawar PS.

The officers detained Mohammed at the Beawar PS from 4 March 2007 through 7 March 2007. During that period, every night the police officers tied Mohammed's hands behind his back and hung him upside down. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, and Constable Jagdish beat Mohammed with belts and sticks every night. The officers also made abusive comments about Mohammed's caste. The officers also kept Mohammed in a constant state of hunger and thirst during his detention.

On 7 March 2007, the police officers filed a false theft case against Mohammed.

On 9 March 2007, Mohammed paid SI Likhma Ram and SI Aatma Ram Rs. 10,000 for his release. The officers threatened serious consequences if Mohammed spoke about his detention.

On 11 March 2007, doctors at the Amrit Kaur Hospital in Beawar, including Dr. Hemnant Chauhan, refused to treat Mohammed because he was a suspect in the false theft case and because Mohammed explained that he had received his injuries from the police.

As a result of his detention at the Beawar PS, Mohammed is unable to move his left hand.

Even though the discussion was proceeding smoothly, the Dadwadi CI forcefully interrupted the meeting.

SI Chuttan Lal and PCs Abdul Hayed and Pyarelal grabbed Arjun by his hair and abused his caste. The POs told Arjun to stop his public service and "shut-up". The POs forced others out of the office, leaving Arjun alone with the POs. Many women and children were injured when they were pushed outside the office. The POs beat Arjun and then pushed him outside. Abdul Salam, a 35 years-old handicapped male, was injured when he was pushed into the police jeep.

Arjun went to the PS to file a case, but the police refused to register it. He, therefore, filed a case in the court.

When Asha replied that she still had work to do, the police would threaten to throw her property outside.

The officers asked for a bribe, and provided examples of other shopkeepers who paid bribes to keep their shops open late. Asha refused to pay. The officers responded by using their lathis to break things in the shop, including the shop glass and a Photostat machine.

Asha called Sunder Das; together, they went to the Ganj Thana. There, ASI Ram Narayan Pareek refused to file a report, instead insulting them and sending them away.

On 5 October 2007, Asha and Sunder Das attended the condolence for a resident of their locality. Four policemen suddenly arrived and began a lathi-charge against the people there. One of the officers recognised Asha and hit her with a lathi four or five times. Asha ran into her house.

Asha and Sunder Das went to the Ganj Thana to file a report, but the police refused to accept it.

DSP Naresh Kumar assured Asha and Sunder Das that he would take action. No action was taken.

The police continue to trouble Asha at her shop.

But on 7 June 2007, the police stopped the protestors and told them that only 4-5 persons could enter. Some of the leaders of the group said that all the people shall enter up to the railings of the Collector's office, but that only the representatives would go beyond it to meet the collector. They assured the POs that there would be no chaos.

The POs opened the main gate, but then stopped the protestors and began pushing them. Some POs in civilian clothes pushed women and abused dalits by calling them names and beating them. The POs pushed women and girls, causing them to fall down. A stampede ensued, injuring several people. Those who tried to negotiate with the POs were falsely charged for creating a traffic jam.

They protested and the police used force to push them aside. This caused the crowd to start throwing stones at the police. In order to control the crowd, the police *lathi* charged.

Many were injured in the charge, motorbikes were confiscated, and protestors were arrested. They were released on bail six days later.

Kamal Kishore went to the Alwar Gate PS to file a report. There, he saw the PC sitting under a tree. The PC asked Kamal Kishore why he had come, and whether he had not had enough that morning. Kamal Kishore replied that he had come to file a case against the PC.

The PC took Kamal Kishore inside the station, where he slapped Kamal Kishore four or five times and then hit him with a stick on his back and hand. Kamal Kishore shouted in pain.

The PC detained Kamal Kishore in a barrack.

At 10.00pm, the PC returned and asked whether Kamal Kishore had learned his lesson. Kamal Kishore asked the PC to spare him and to let him return to his mother. The PC released Kamal Kishore, warning him never again to ask for money for the PC's purchases from his shop. The PC also threatened to beat Kamal Kishore until he could not walk if he complained against the PC.

Afterwards, the PC would frequently come to Kamal Kishore's shop and take goods without payment. No action has been taken against him.

Kishan was presented in court, and remanded to jail. After Kishan was released on bail, he was taken to the hospital for treatment. The doctors recommended surgery, as both his eardrums were damaged during the police beating.

According to police, Gulab denied any association with Kishan's family. She alleges that she was receiving prank phone calls from an unknown caller. On the date of the incident, the police received information that youths were fighting at a public telephone booth near Ajmer road. A few PCs including Gulab Singh were sent to investigate. When the youths saw the police, they dispersed. Kishan started running and the police caught him. When he was searched, the POs found that Kishan's mobile phone that matched the number of the prank caller. The POs denied they beat Kishan.

Laxmandas attempted to file a complaint to the CI at Dadawari Thana, but he directed him to the Nayapura Thana. At 3.00pm, Laxmandas reached the Nayapura Thana and submitted his written complaint. The police took no action on the complaint. On 27 October 2007, Laxmandas filed a complaint in the Court. Still no action has been taken.

The SHO then began pressuring Laxman Samariya to vacate the police quarters. Laxman Samariya agreed to vacate the quarters on receipt of his suspension orders.

On 15 September 2007, in front of other officers, the SHO took off Laxman Samariya's clothes and beat him.

On hearing Laxman Samariya's screams, Nirmala and Ramlal arrived. However, the SHO threatened to kill Laxman Samariya if she and he did not vacate the quarters. The SHO used caste-related insults.

At 10.30pm, ASI Om Prakash and SHO Ramswaroop arrived, took Nirmala's house keys, and threw their belongings out of the Quarter. They threatened to place opium in the house and to trap Laxman Samariya and Nirmala with a false case if they did not vacate the premises.

On 18 September 2007, Nirmala and Ramlal filed complaints with the Chief Minister, the Home Minister, the IG, and the SP. The SP assured them that an impartial enquiry and appropriate proceedings would take place. No action has been taken.

ASI Bhivaram and the SHO have stated that Laxman Samariya is an alcoholic who had arrived drunk for his duties on several occasions, despite the SHO's admonitions. He has also stated that on 15 September 2007, Laxman Samariya arrived drunk at the Thana, began screaming, and took off his own clothes.

On 8 September 2007, Sajjan went to the PS. SHO Vishnoi asked Sajjan how much money was stolen from his house, and where he obtained the money. SHO Vishnoi accused Sajjan of stealing the money and threatened to beat Sajjan until he admitted where he stole the money. Sajjan refuted SHO Vishnoi's allegations. SHO Vishnoi was angered and punched Sajjan in his face, causing his nose to bleed. SHO Vishnoi grabbed a stick and hit Sajjan three or four times on his back and pelvis. Sajjan escaped from SHO Vishnoi, who threatened Sajjan not to return to the PS or he would be locked up.

Sajjan retained an advocate who filed a complaint on behalf of Sajjan in the court. When SHO Vishnoi learned of the complaint, he went to Sajjan's house and threatened file a false case against him and lock him in jail for life.

Setha's father insisted on writing a report. ASI Puranmal scolded him and pushed Setha's father, who fell on the stairs. ASI Puranmal kicked Setha's father and said that he was looking for a thief and Setha's father was a thief. ASI Puranmal grabbed Setha's father, pushed him into the jail and locked him inside.

Setha begged ASI Puranmal to leave her father. ASI Puranmal made Setha sit in a corner for an hour, and then ordered her to leave the PS. Setha's father was released about five hours later. There were injury marks all over his body.

Setha's father filed complaint through an advocate, and the court rendered a decision in favour of Setha, but still Setha's in-laws continued to threaten her and her family. Setha is too afraid to seek help from the police.

After three days, Anna Ram and Shравan Kumar were discharged.

He directed one PC to provide victims medical attention, and then directed victims to leave the PS. Victims insisted that they wanted to register a complaint. SHO Chowdhary refused to file the complaint for some time, but finally told PO Meethu Singh to file the report. The police have refused to take any action against the three RAC Jawans.
