9 <sup>th</sup> & 10 <sup>th</sup> April 2015	Three witnesses who had escaped from the Andhra Pradesh Red Sander Anti Smuggling Task Force were produced to the fact finding team by the village panchayat presidents
13.04.2015	Two of the eye-witnesses Mr. Sekar and Mr. Balachandran were produced to the National Human Rights Commission in New Delhi and their statements were recorded
14 <sup>th</sup> & 15 <sup>th</sup> April 2015	High level fact finding team comprising of Justice H.Suresh, Mr. Satyabrata Pal, Prof. Jawahirullah, Dr. Saviour Selva Suresh, Mr. Henri Tiphagne conducted a fact finding mission in the place of the incident and visited the families of the victims
15.04.2015	The third eye witness Mr. Elango was produced to the Joint Registrar of the National Human Rights Commission in Pondicherry
23.04.2015	National Human Rights Commission took suo moto cognizance of the incident and had conducted a hearing in Hyderabad, where it gave its recommendations to the Andhra Pradesh government
09.05.2015	The report of the High level fact finding mission was released in a public function in Madurai by Mr. Vaiko, General Secretary of MDMK party
23 <sup>rd</sup> & 24 <sup>th</sup> May 2015	Special Investigation Team formed by the Andhra Pradesh government visited the People's Watch Headquarters in Madurai to record the statements of the three ey-witnesses and of Mr. Henri Tiphagne, Ms. Palaniammal
26.05.2015	Public meeting in solidarity of the families of the victims was organized to commemorate the United Nations International Day in solidarity of the victims of torture
06.07.2015	Requisition letter to People's Watch for filing case before the Hon High Court at Hyderabad received from the family members of the victims. Petition filed before the Hon. High Court on behalf of the petitioners and the same stands posted to 03.08.2015. Still pending.
15.07.2015	All party meeting in Chennai to discuss about the future course of actions which was attended by Mr. Vaiko, General Secretary of MDMK and Mr. Henri Tiphagne
19 <sup>th</sup> & 20 <sup>th</sup> July 2015	The three witnesses had been asked to show the route in which they had travelled on the night of the incident to the Special Investigation Tem. They were produced to the SIT Tirunvannamalai and were accompanied by People's Watch representatives Mr. Aseervatham, Ms. Palaniammal, Advocates Mr. Senthilraja, Mr. Ravi, Mr. Umar
21.07.2015	Implead petition with affidavit filed before the Hon. High Court Andhra Pradesh by the petitioner/proposed respondent Mr. Henri Tiphagne in WP.No.15767/2015 and the same was adjourned to 03.08.2015. Still pending.
22.07.2015	The eye witnesses were sent back to their house
28.07.2015	Petitions were filed in Andhra Pradesh High Court by Advocate Vrindra Grover asking to add the eye witnesses as party to the case
31.07.2015	In an act of pacifying the victims, the Government of Tamilnadu offered jobs of the family members of the victim

06.08.2015	Tamilnadu government announces jobs for the family members of the victim to pacify them
10.08.2015	Summons was served in the houses of the three eye witnesses for the recording of supplementary statements.
13 <sup>th</sup> & 14 <sup>th</sup> August 2015	The Special Investigation had visited the house of the three eye witnesses to record supplementary statements by them were interrogated for more than five hours without the presence of the advocates
06.09.2015	One day Hunger strike on requesting the Tamilnadu Government to intervene in the case of the AP Encounter killings. Mr. Vaiko, General Secretary, MDMK, Mr. Thirumavalavan, VCK, Mr. G.Ramakrishnan and the leaders from CPI were giving speech in the program. There were more than 5000 people participated in the hunger strike. The victim's family members, three witnesses and the panchayat leaders from their area were also participated in Polur.
28.09.2015 & 02.10.2015	Advocates Senthilraja, Ravi visited the prisons in Andhra Pradesh where persons from Tamilnadu were arrested on charges on illegal cutting of red sanders were lodged. Initially they had identified 440 persons who were lodged in those prisons and the help of Legal Services Authority was sought to get bail for them.
